



How to obtain a Digital DJ Licence from PPL

The PPL Digital DJ Licence is designed for DJs who want to keep digital copies of sound recordings to use when DJing in public.

If you are interested in taking out the Digital DJ Licence, please read (and ensure that you have understood) the Digital DJ Licence Terms and Conditions, which are also available on the Digital DJ page of PPL's website. You will also find some explanatory FAQs, which we hope will answer any questions you may have.

Please then complete the Digital DJ Licence Application Form, sign it and return it to PPL either:

- (a) scanned, by email to digitaldj@ppluk.com,
- (b) by fax to 020 7534 1374, or
- (c) by post to Digital DJ Licensing, PPL, 1 Upper James Street, London, W1F 9DE.

If you wish to pay by cheque, please post your Digital DJ Licence Application Form to PPL and enclose a cheque for the appropriate licence fee, plus VAT, made payable to Phonographic Performance Limited.

If you wish to pay by credit or debit card, please tick the appropriate box on the Digital DJ Licence Application Form and our Digital DJ Team will contact you, using the details you have supplied on your Digital DJ Licence Application Form, once we receive it.

The Licence Fee

The Licence Fee is currently £200 per annum, plus VAT – i.e. £235 in total.

Surcharge

Please note that, as per Clause 10.1 of the Digital DJ Licence Terms and Conditions (and as explained in the FAQs), a surcharge of **50%** (fifty percent) will be applied to the Licence Fee in certain circumstances.

However, the surcharge will not apply to you if you apply for and pay for the Digital DJ Licence before 1 January 2006.
